Masuda Funai Attorneys Contribute to 2026 IICLE Immigration Law Handbooks

Masuda Funai attorneys Fazila Vaid, Julie Emerick and Anne Miller are contributing authors to the 2026 Immigration Law Handbook published by the Illinois Institute for Continuing Legal Education (IICLE).
